Drink 8-10 glasses of water every day.

Regular eye checkup at least once a year

Consult your doctor immediately if you watch any warning signs like

- Blurry, cloudy, or double vision
- Flashing lights or rings around lights
- Any sudden change in your vision
- Trouble seeing signs or straight lines
- Blank, dark, or floating spots in your vision
- Trouble seeing out of the corner of your eye
- Pain, pressure, or constant redness in your eyes
